### **Job Description**

- Provide materials and activities to meet each child's developmental needs as part of his/her learning plan.
- Present the Montessori materials in an interesting way in order to stimulate the interest of the child and generate a love of learning.
- Has an understanding and knowledge of the Primary School Curriculum.
- Assess and record each child's progress.
- Work as a team member within the wider school community and liaise with other relevant individuals such as educational psychologists.
- Uphold the policies of St Nicholas Montessori School and St Nicholas Montessori Society of Ireland Ltd. at all times and works in co-operation with other staff members to advance and promote the educational ethos of the school.
- Provide feedback to parents on a pupil's progress at parents' meetings.
- Organise and participate in school events, outings and activities which may take place outside normal attendance (8.15am to 3.00pm daily), including weekends or evenings.
- Facilitates student teachers from St. Nicholas Montessori College on teaching practice in a supportive and encouraging manner.
- Undertake Continuous Professional Development.
- Have knowledge and understanding of the regulatory requirements of the Child Care Act 1991 (Early Years Services) Regulations 2016 and the Child Safeguarding and Child Protection Policy and be fully compliant with them at all times.
- Have knowledge and understanding of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act, 2005.
- The Teacher works in collaboration with an Assistant Teacher in the classroom.
